

## Newcastle Music Festival Events – Venue Accessibility



### Adamstown Uniting Church

**Access ramp:** There is flat access from UC carpark as well as ramp access to the entrance foyer.

**Parking:** A disabled parking space is available in the church carpark near the flat access gate. (Bruncker Roadside) Enter carpark via Bruncker Road and exit via Glebe Road. Ample parking is available in vicinity.

**The facilities** (incl. disabled toilet) are located at the back of the entrance foyer.



### Christ Church Cathedral

**An access ramp** is situated on the harbour-side of the Cathedral.

**Parking:** There is a disabled parking space at the western end of the Cathedral.

**The facilities** (incl. disabled toilet) are located inside the Cathedral through the archway on the southern side of the Nave Altar.

**Hearing Loop:** The Cathedral has a hearing loop which covers the front six pews on the south side of the Cathedral. Switch hearing aid to 'T' setting to benefit.



### Newcastle Art Gallery

**Access:** The gallery has flat access from Laman Street. It is a two-storey building and the lift is directly to the left of the front door as you first arrive.

A courtesy wheelchair is available on request. Drop off is permitted at the front entrance on Laman Street. (Laman Street is one way accessible from Darby Street) There are 4 accessible car parks on Laman Street.

**Parking:** Free 1 and 2-hour parking is available in and around Darby Street, and free 30-minute parking is available on Laman Street.

Paid all day parking is available in the car park behind the Gallery in Queen Street. Time limited parking, paid ticketing systems and compliance officers operate in the Civic Park and Cooks Hill area. Please check the street signs for parking regulations when you visit.

**The facilities** (including access bathroom) are on the ground floor on the left-hand side as you first arrive.



### The Station

#### Access:

The Station has flat access from Scott and Watt Street as well as from Wharf Road.

#### Parking:

There are hundreds of car parks within a 12-minute walk. It is also easy to park in Newcastle West and ride the Light Rail in!

**The facilities** (incl. disabled toilet with flat access) are located on 'The Station Platform' next to the walk-through to Scott Street.



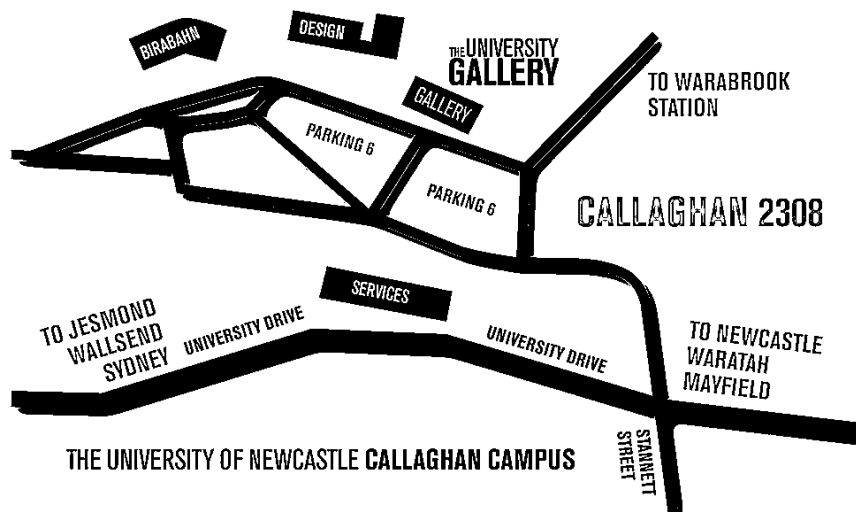
### University Gallery

University of Newcastle, Callaghan

**Access ramp:** There is an access ramp to the entrance of the gallery.

**Parking:** Use the Stannet Street traffic lights entrance on University Drive to carpark 6 and the closest to the Uni Gallery (GS). Parking is free after 5.30pm on weekdays. Please check the parking regulations.

**The facilities** are located under the gallery.





### Newcastle City Hall

**Access:** Accessible entry to Newcastle City Hall is from the side entrances at Christie Place (off King Street, Newcastle) or Wheeler Place.

The elevator to Level 1 & 2 is located at the Wheeler Place end of the building. The elevator size is as follows: door width 0.8m x depth 1.1m and internal width 1.2m. If you require assistance when you are in the building, please call one of the building Commissionaires on 4974 2950.

**Parking:**

Accessible Parking spaces can be found at the following locations:

- Cnr King Street and Burwood Street (near Newcastle City Council) - 5 spaces
- Auckland Street (between Hunter Street and King Street) 2 Spaces
- Hunter Street (Near Wheeler Place and the Civic Theatre Newcastle) 1 space

Spaces are also provided in the carpark behind the Newcastle Regional Library accessed via Queen Street.

**Facilities:** There is a unisex accessible toilet facility (right hand transfer) located on Level 1 of Newcastle City Hall. From the elevator turn left and then sharp left again, walk along the corridor approximately 15m and the door is on the right.
